



MKE UNITED ANTI-DISPLACEMENT FUND

The MKE United Anti-Displacement Fund provides grants to eligible homeowners who live in near downtown neighborhoods to help them pay for increases in their property taxes.

The Anti-Displacement Fund is being led by MKE United, a cross sector collaborative working to grow and support neighborhood investment while ensuring that long term and current community residents in near downtown neighborhoods can share in the benefits of new development.

Eligibility Requirements for the Program

- You must own and live in a property in the eligible area (refer to maps). Eligible areas were determined based on having significant increases in assessed values above City averages over the past five years.
- You must have owned the property since at least January 1, 2015, or inherited it from a family member who owned it since that date.
- You must be current on real estate taxes and not be subject to mortgage foreclosure.
- Your annual household income must be equal to or below the limits in the chart below:

Program Assistance

For new applicants, if you meet eligibility requirements and your application is approved, the program will make a tax payment on your behalf in the amount that is the difference between your tax bill for 2020 and your tax bill for 2021. For example, if your property taxes were \$2,000 in 2020 and \$2,400 in 2021, the program will pay the difference of \$400 (\$2,400-\$2,000). Special assessments and charges, penalties and late fees are not included in calculating assistance available through the fund. Because there was an assessment freeze in 2021, it is likely your property assessment remained the same between 2020 and 2021 and it may also be possible that your property taxes will not increase for 2021. Even if your property taxes do not increase this year, we would still strongly encourage you to apply for the program in 2021.

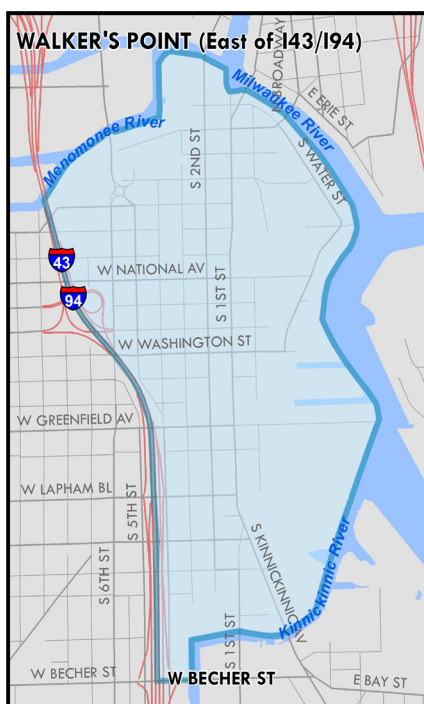
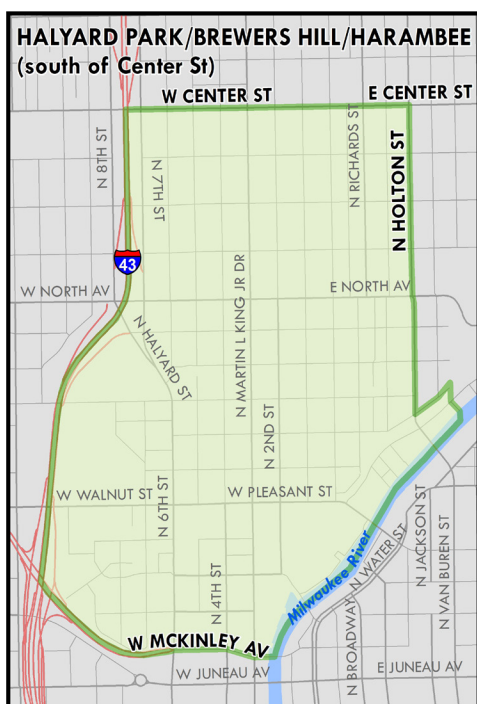
